

Thank you for your interest in hosting a Rent Party to benefit Neighbor to Neighbor! Rent Parties originated in the 1920s as a way for neighbors to help neighbors cover their rent costs during hard times. Today, Neighbor to Neighbor provides the same opportunity for service through fun Rent Parties. All proceeds raised by your Rent Party go directly towards preventing homelessness and displacement of Larimer County neighbors. Party Hosts will also receive two complimentary tickets to Neighbor to Neighbor's Annual Rent Party celebration.

Sample Theme Ideas:

The benefit of hosting a Rent Party is that it's your party – your theme, your schedule, your people, your fun! You can throw a new and unique party, or you can incorporate philanthropy into an existing party you host. Here are a few party themes that have enjoyed great success:

- Birthday
- Housewarming
- Special or Milestone Event
- Backyard BBQ
- Holiday or Themed Event
- Corporate Event

Host Responsibilities

- Set the venue, date and time
- Decide on your theme and what refreshments and entertainment to provide
- Invite guests

Quick Tips for a Successful Rent Party

- Make it clear that your party has a philanthropic mission and communicate why you care about N2N's mission. Your passion will energize your friends!
- Set a fundraising goal and let your party invitees know what that goal is.
 - We like to tie the dollars raised with the impact it will make in the community. To do so, we recommend setting a goal like, "Prevent homelessness for one local family by collectively raising \$500!" or "We believe our community can make a huge difference and are setting the goal of preventing homelessness for three families. That means we need to pool our resources to raise \$1,500!" Consider a "cover charge" to the party with a suggested minimum donation.
 - This concept works well with open-invitation parties, and we recommend setting a suggested amount, such as a \$10 or \$20 cover charge.
- Consider matching or meeting the goal up to a certain amount to incentivize your friends and neighbors to donate.
- Birthday party hosts might ask for donations instead of gifts, or Potluck hosts might ask for a dish and an equivalent donation that would have gone towards out to dinner together. Be creative!
- Have a hat or jar or a themed container that you can collect donations in a visible way.
- Use an invite, social media and personal invitations to help spread the word.
 - Include a link to donate at n2n.org/donate for those who can't attend, but still want to support your party. Please ask them to mention your party in the note section of the donation page.
- Consider hosting an online fundraiser if a house party isn't quite your style. Reach out to Brooke Cunningham to discuss setting that up.
- After your party, send a note or email to celebrate the Rent Party's success and to share the difference they helped make in our community.
